ABC Card Games (letters & sounds)

ABC Telephone

Sit in rows. Place big letters at the front and small letters at the back of the lines. Be the fastest to whisper to your line to get the correct letter. First player takes a big letter card then whispers the letters' sound (or name) to the person sitting behind. Continue whispering to the last person in the line. The last person selects the correct card and passes it to the front. Fastest team that does it correctly wins. Change the person in the front to the back of the line.

ABC Race

Sit in a circle. Shuffle and deal out all the big letter cards (or small letter cards). When the dealer says "Go," players work together to put the ABC's in order. Fastest team that does it correctly wins.

Find it Quick! (karuta)

Sit in a circle. Shuffle and place the one card set into a draw pile. Place the other set cards face up in the middle. Players win cards by being the first to slap. Beginning on the dealer's left, player draws a card and say the letter or sound aloud. All players except the card reader search for the card and place their hand on top. First player wins the card. The player to the left reads from the draw pile next. Repeat the process until there are no cards. When there are three cards or less, the reader can be tricky and say letters or sounds not present. If a player mistakenly hits the card, they are out during that readers' turn. The player with the most cards wins. For new players, start with eight matching pairs or half of the cards. Amend game to have one player search and slap at a time by using a fly swatter.
